Park City has two world famous Vail owned ski mountains: Park City and Canyons – with a gondola between them. There is plenty of beginner, intermediate, and advanced skiing available. There is also an interesting gold mine downhill ski tour available where you visit mine sites and hear the history of the local gold rush.

The Olympics were held in Park City in 2002 and they developed great cross country skiing in several places plus XC in area parks.

Peaks Hotel Lodging: We are staying at the Peaks Hotel in downtown Park City.
